The cost is still just £15 per annum. Please note that applications to use the car park are open only to parishioners! They are not open to other family members or extended family (unless they too are parishioners). Please also note that only one form can be obtained for each parishioner applying and that each parishioner can only apply to use one vehicle. Please also note the terms of use of the car park on the form. To allow people time to renew over the Christmas period we are extending current passes until Friday 17th January 2020.

<u>Email Scam Warning</u> There has been a recent case of an elderly parishioner being scammed out of £500 because they received an email which they thought was from their parish priest requesting her to purchase gift vouchers for his niece as he was too busy over Christmas. The scammer may well have accessed the parish website where both the parishioner's name and the parish priest's name are published. The fact that the scammer did not ask for money or bank details may have made the parishioner feel that this was a genuine request. However, the gift voucher numbers were requested which will enable the scammer to spend the money – never respond to any such requests no matter how genuine they may seem!
