Coronavirus: Parish Precautions & Guidance

As you will be aware, the UK is now moving towards the 'delay' phase of the plan to control the spread of the Coronavirus. At time of writing, the Bishop is not currently aware of cases of infection within our local communities or linked to our parish communities. At national level, the Bishops of England & Wales having circulated advice we have received regarding three potential stages of response in our parishes and have not mandated changes across the country other than the clear **requirements of good hygiene to be followed**. (The parish has ordered supplies of hand sanitiser, but as you may have heard, supplies are currently running low and as yet we do not have a delivery date on this, but liquid soap is available in all toilets in the church & hall).

The Bishop has now also strongly advised <u>to suspend the physical Sign of Peace</u>, and the parish under Father Anthony will be following this advice. Instead, a simple bow or saying 'peace be with you' may be followed.

Further steps will be taken by the parish if or when necessary.
