Parish Maintenance Work Update & Fundraising Appeal:

Presbytery Front Doors – The front doors of the presbytery are scheduled to be replaced soon owing to over warping.

Parish Hall Boiler – Work will commence on the morning of Tuesday 10th September to install a new boiler for the parish hall – the work is expected to be completed by the end of next week.

Church Roof Repair – Work has recently been completed to repair a break in the seal of the church roof, which caused a leak with the heavy rainfall over recent months.

These repairs will be expensive to the parish, costing us a total of over £10,000. Over recent years, the parish has undertaken several urgent costly repairs, several of which parishioners have kindly donated money towards.
