The parish has now undertaken the urgent repair and maintenance work as detailed in recent months. These repairs, including work on the church roof, the replacement of the hall boiler, and new front doors for the presbytery, have cost the parish a total of over £10,000.

We are extremely grateful for the immense generosity and response from our parishioners over recent months. We have now received £16,815.

The excess funds will be used for the future maintenance of the parish properties, which is often ongoing, and future work is already planned following a recent health and safety assessment, so any further donations will not be rejected.
