Pope Francis wants to hear what you think!

In the lead-up to the Synod on Young People, the Faith and Vocational Discernment, Pope Francis told young people the Church "wishes to listen to your voice, your sensitivities and your faith; even your doubts and your criticism." Young people (13-29) in England and Wales can do so in an online poll. There is a different poll seeking the views of anyone who is a parent, grandparent, teacher, chaplain, youth worker, priest - or anyone who regularly engages with young people. The information collected will contribute to the working instrument for the Synod scheduled for October 2018 in Rome.

The two online surveys created by the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales will be open until Friday 30th June 2017 to collect views, and should only take around 20 minutes to complete.
