

**St. Teresa's Car Park Renewal 2017** Renewal forms for use of the parish car park by parishioners are now available in the black holder under the notice board at the back of Church. **Blue permits are now out of date!** These forms will be available after weekend masses & on request from Fr. Anthony after weekday masses. Use of the car park is dependent on the following conditions being adhered to:

- Parking is solely for the use of the parishioners of Sacred Heart and St. Teresa's, Wilmslow; St. Pius's, Alderley Edge and St. Benedict's, Handforth and others with permission.
- Use of the car park is for short periods, to enable parishioners to do shopping. It is not for all-day use.
- Please ensure that the Permit is always displayed in the front windscreen visible from the outside of the vehicle, and please ensure the barrier is closed after entering & leaving the car park to minimize abusive parking.

We still seek a donation of only £10 per car. Forms should be returned to Father Anthony. Permits will be ready for collection in the box at the back of church (please allow up to 2 weeks processing time). If you require your new passes to be posted to you, please include a stamped addressed envelope with your application.
