Please note therefore the early mass on Friday 17th May at 7.00 am – also there will be no morning mass/exposition/confession on Saturday 18th May. Our parish friend, Fr. Peter Edmonds SJ, will kindly say the Vigil & Sunday masses for us in Fr. Anthony's absence over the weekend of 18th/19th May – there will be Eucharistic services subject to availability of ministers from Monday 20th May – Wednesday 22nd May. Please also note on Thursday 23rd May that mass will not be in the morning but the evening at 7.30 pm. Email Scam: The Diocese has recently reported to us that somebody from one of our parishes was recently sent an email purporting to be from a member of the clergy. The email asked them to send vouchers so that they could be given to cancer patients in need and the story behind it was very convincing. If you receive any emails asking you to send money or vouchers, please be aware that this is most likely a scam. The email may seem to be from someone you know, but it is very easy for a scammer to gather this information and target a person's contact list. Never send money without checking the authenticity of the sender, even if it seems like the request is urgent. Please note we will never email you asking for money.
