Shrewsbury Cathedral - Article by Bishop Mark Davies, Catholic Herald

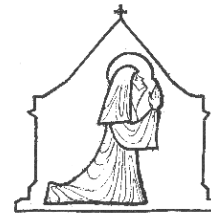

UPDATE: Fundraising Appeal: Urgent Parish Maintenance Work

As mentioned last week, the parish is currently undertaking urgent repair and maintenance work in several parts of the parish buildings (church, presbytery and hall) as detailed below.

We are very thankful to have received over £1,000 from parishioners just in the last week!

Presbytery Front Doors – The front doors of the presbytery are scheduled to be replaced soon owing to over warping.

Parish Hall Boiler – Work was completed last week to install a new boiler in the parish hall after the previous one had failed beyond repair. Central heating/Hot water is now back available.

Church Roof Repair – Work has recently been completed to repair a break in the seal of the church roof, which caused a leak with the heavy rainfall over recent months.

These repairs are expensive to the parish, costing us a total of over £10,000.

We are always grateful to the ongoing generosity of our parishioners.
