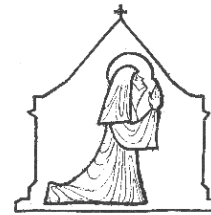
Wilmslow Wells 27th annual major fundraiser, Gardens Day, 29th June 2019
