*"We hold in prayer all the victims of the terrible events in Manchester and all their families; and pray for the police and emergency services in their vital work for public safety and for those now caring for the injured in our hospitals. We stand with all the people of Greater Manchester in the determination to overcome the hate and violence which erupted in the centre of the city last week. Our faith teaches how evil is ultimately overcome by good. The example of the people of Manchester in caring for each other and even opening their doors to help strangers amid those fearful events points to how it is such greatness of heart which overcomes everything that conspires to divide us and will strengthen the bonds between us. In the face of such homicidal hatred we pray that the response of every community will similarly be seen in active charity and solidarity."*
