Shrewsbury Diocese: Foundation Governor Vacancies

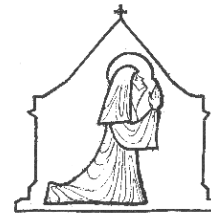

National Eucharistic Congress - Spiritual Preparation in June 2018 in the Parishes

I write concerning the preparations for the forthcoming National Eucharistic Congress in which I hope the whole Diocese will be able to share. On the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Sunday 3rd June, I would be grateful if a Holy Hour of Adoration could be organised in all of the parishes of the Diocese.

To the Congress Delegates - those who are already committed to taking part in the National Eucharistic Congress and those who are hoping to do so - I will be issuing a general invitation for them to join me at St Anthony’s, Wythenshawe, at 3pm on Sunday 24th June for a Holy Hour of Adoration in immediate preparation for the Congress and to formally commission them as Diocesan Delegates.

A pack of liturgical and devotional resources will shortly be sent to all the parishes together with a poster to advertise your own Holy Hour. The spiritual significance of the National Eucharistic Congress will be found in the participation in the three days in September but also in the preparation in all of our parishes and communities.

Another excellent way for the Diocese to prepare for the Eucharistic Congress will be the Diocesan Symposium in St Ambrose College, Hale Barns on Saturday 9th June, repeated in Shrewsbury on Sunday 10th June when Father Oliver Treanor will be speaking on the theme: Maelstrom of Love: The Eucharist, Source and Centre of the Sacramental Life.
