Holy Week 2024

Palm Sunday of the Passion of Our Lord (24th March)

Please note the **10.30 am** mass on Palm Sunday begins with a procession from the Parish hall.

Monday – Wednesday of Holy Week (25th – 27th March)

Please note there will be Mass each morning at **10 am** as usual.

The Chrism Mass, at which the Bishop blesses the Holy oils used in the administration of Baptism, Confirmation and the Sacrament of the Sick will be celebrated this year at Birkenhead in Saint Michael and All Angels Woodchurch on Wednesday of Holy Week, 27th March at 7.00 pm

The Easter Triduum

The Easter Triduum is a single celebration of the Last Supper, The Lord's Passion and Death, culminating in the Easter Vigil. If possible, please try to come to all three parts.

Holy/Maundy Thursday (28th March): Mass of the Lord's Last Supper

Please note there will be no morning mass on this day. Mass of the Lord's Last Supper will be in the evening at **8.00 pm** followed by watching before the Altar of Repose until 11 pm.

Good Friday (29th March): Liturgy of the Passion of Our Lord

Stations of the Cross will be in church in the morning at 11 am.

The Liturgy of the Lord's Passion will start at **3.00 pm**.

Father Vijay will be available for Confessions following the Liturgy.

Holy Saturday (30th March)

There is no public worship on this day until the evening and the sacraments are not celebrated, except for those who are seriously ill.

The Easter Vigil begins at **8.00 pm**, and marks the first Mass of Easter.

Easter Sunday (31st March)
