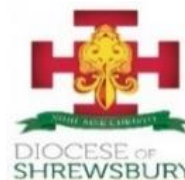

### **Parish Pilgrimage to Shrewsbury Cathedral**

We are planning to organise a visit to the Cathedral in the autumn by train (if running) or coach. More information will follow closer to the time – further details from the Diocese are below:

*“We are delighted post-Covid to be able to welcome pilgrims to The Cathedral once more.*

*Parishes and parish groups are invited to book a pilgrimage day at the Cathedral. This will include a tour of the Cathedral where you will see how the reordering of the Cathedral is evolving, including the restored east window and the original, recently uncovered encaustic tiles, (which are being matched and recast by ‘Craven Dunnill Tiles’, whose manufacturing background began at the Jackfield Tile Factory in Ironbridge in 1872).*

*Mass will be celebrated at 12.15pm and followed by a light lunch provided by the on-site Orchard Café. The cost of the day is £10 per head.”*
