## **ANNOUNCEMENT TO THE PARISHES OF SAINT PIUS X, ALDERLEY EDGE, SAINT BENEDICT, HANDFORTH, AND SACRED HEART AND SAINT TERESA, WILMSLOW**

The Bishop has asked Father Anthony McGrath who until now has served the Parish of Saint Benedict, Handforth, to become the new Parish Priest of Saint Pius X, Alderley Edge, Sacred Heart and Saint Teresa, Wilmslow, together with Saint Benedict's, Handforth. The Bishop has appointed Father Moses Ibeh as Assistant Priest to work with Father Anthony. The two priests will be resident at Saint Teresa's, Wilmslow. The new appointments will take effect from the second Sunday in September.
