## The Assisted Dying Bill

Bishop Mark writes, "On Friday 20<sup>th</sup> June, by a narrow margin, the House of Commons voted to approve the Third Reading of the Terminally III (Adults) End of Life Bill to open the door to euthanasia in the guise of medically assisted suicide. Barely a dozen MP's changing their minds would have averted this threat to some of the most vulnerable. The passage of this legislation would constitute one of the greatest changes to society in our history and a seismic shift from its Christian foundations. As this Private Member's Bill now proceeds to the House of Lords, the level of concern expressed in the aftermath of the Commons vote regarding the safety of its provisions; lack of adequate scrutiny and even of time given to its debate together with the narrowness of its majority offers some hope that this legislation will be reassessed. We must thank all parishioners who took time to write and meet with their MPs. It will be important to remind everyone discouraged by these events that the fight against euthanasia is not over despite the outcome of the vote on 20th June. We hope and pray its dangers of medically assisted suicide will be quickly recognised and we cannot doubt our witness to the sanctity of human life, especially in the care of the sick and the aged, will be more needed than ever. We can be thankful for all the national leadership of Cardinal Nichols and Archbishop Sherrington, especially in recent days highlighting the plight of our care homes and hospices in the face of this fearful legislation."

## The De-Criminalising Of Abortion

Bishop Mark writes, "It would be hard to imagine that our legislature could have fallen to such a level that during the same week on Tuesday 17th June, by an amendment moved to the Criminal Justice Bill we see the prospect of the greatest change to our lamentable abortion laws in more than half a century following barely two hours debate. By 379 votes to 137 the House of Commons voted to remove legal protections from the unborn child up to birth when a woman acts to induce an abortion at home. This change to the law devalues the life of the unborn up to birth and cannot serve the safety of women. Even though the majority in the House of Commons was overwhelming we can hope the House of Lords will exercise its responsibility to reassess this amendment to a Government Bill."
